

deemed fireproof, shall not be erected, placed, or repaired, and to direct that any and all buildings within such limits prescribed shall be made and constructed of fireproof material, and to prohibit the repairing and rebuilding of wooden buildings within such limits, when the same shall be damaged to the extent of fifty (50) per cent on the value thereof, and to prescribe the manner of ascertaining such value and damages.'"

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 37.

AN ACT TO AMEND CHAPTER THIRTY (30) OF THE SPECIAL LAWS OF THE YEAR ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE (1881), ENTITLED AN ACT TO REDUCE THE LAWS INCORPORATING THE VILLAGE OF MORRIS, COUNTY OF STEVENS, STATE OF MINNESOTA, AND THE ACT AMENDATORY THEREOF, INTO ONE ACT, AND TO AMEND THE SAME.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. Section sixteen (16) of chapter thirty (30) of the special laws of one thousand eight hundred and eighty-one (1881), is hereby amended as follows: Twenty-seventh—The common council of the village of Morris shall have power to license and regulate the business of draying within said village, and may, by appropriate ordinances, impose license fees for carrying on said business, and punish violations of its provisions.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect from and after its passage.
