

within the corporate limits of said town or village, except so far as the same are incompatible with the provisions of this charter, and the penalties imposed thereby may be enforced by indictment and trial in the district court in and for said county, but the justice of the peace of said town or village, provided for in this charter, and other justices of the peace in and for said county, shall have concurrent jurisdiction in all said matters.

SEC. 2. This act to take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 63.

AN ACT TO AMEND CHAPTER THIRTY-SIX (36) OF THE SPECIAL LAWS OF A. D. ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-NINE (1879), ENTITLED "AN ACT TO AMEND THE LAW INCORPORATING THE VILLAGE OF SLEEPY EYE, BROWN COUNTY, MINNESOTA."

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section ten (10) of said act is hereby amended by inserting in the twenty-first (21st) line, after the word "allowed," "upon questions of both law and fact."

SEC. 2. That wherever the words "Sleepy Eye" appear and are used in said act the word "Lake" shall be inserted immediately thereafter.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect from and after its passage.
