

CHAPTER 106.

[H. F. No. 88.]

AN ACT FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A NEW JUDICIAL DISTRICT COURT TO BE KNOWN AS THE SIXTEENTH JUDICIAL DISTRICT. AND TO FIX DATES FOR HOLDING COURT THEREIN.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Sec. 1. That the counties of Big Stone, Stevens, Traverse and Wilkin be, and the same are hereby detached from the Twelfth Judicial District, and that the county of Grant be and the same is hereby detached from the Seventh Judicial District, and are hereby created into a Judicial District, to be known as the Sixteenth Judicial District of Minnesota.

SEC. 2. The terms of Court in said district shall be held as follows:

In Stevens county, on the third (3d) Tuesday in May and November of each year.

In Big Stone county, on the first (1st) Tuesday in May and December of each year.

In Traverse county, on the second (2d) Tuesday in March and October of each year.

In the county of Wilkin, on the first (1st) Tuesday in March and October of each year.

In Grant county, on the (4th) Tuesday in May and September of each year.

Judge, how
appointed.

SEC. 3. A District Judge shall be elected therefor at the next general election, and the Governor is hereby authorized to appoint a district Judge for said district to serve until the next general election.

When act to
take effect.

SEC. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
