

## CHAPTER 192.

[H. F. No. 279.]

AN ACT TO EXTEND THE TIME FOR ADJUSTING THE BALANCE DUE THE STATE ON ACCOUNT OF SEED GRAIN LOANS OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY SEVEN (1877), AND ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-EIGHT (1878), AND TO REPEAL SECTION FOURTEEN (14) OF CHAPTER ONE HUNDRED AND FIFTY-SIX (156), GENERAL LAWS OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-SEVEN (1877), REQUIRING COUNTIES TO LEVY GENERAL TAX FOR UNCOLLECTABLE LOANS.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

SECTION 1. That section one (1) of chapter two hundred and twenty-six (226) of the general laws of one thousand eight hundred and eighty-five (1885) be amended by striking out the words "one thousand eight hundred and eighty-five" where it occurs in the second (2d) line of said section, and inserting the words "one thousand eight hundred and eighty-nine (1889)" in lieu thereof. Seed grain.

SEC. 2. That section fourteen (14) of chapter one hundred and fifty-six (156) of the general laws of one thousand eight hundred and seventy-seven (1877), be and the same is hereby repealed,

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage. When act to take effect.
