

CHAPTER 214.

[H. F. No. 52.]

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY FOR THE EXPENSES OF
THE PRESENT SESSION OF THE LEGISLATURE.*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

SECTION 1. That the sum of eighty thousand dollars (\$80,000), or so much thereof as may be necessary, be and the same is hereby appropriated from the general revenue fund for the payment of the per diem, mileage and other expenses of the members and officers of the legislature during the present session.

CHAPTER 215.

[H. F. No. 981.]

AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR TEMPORARY LOANS TO PAY
APPROPRIATIONS FROM THE REVENUE FUND, AND
MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO PAY INTEREST
THEREON.*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

SECTION 1. That the governor, auditor and treasurer are authorized, whenever in their judgment it becomes necessary, in order to meet the current demands in the revenue fund for the payment of appropriations from said fund, to make agreements or contracts with banks or other corporations or persons, to pay warrants issued against the revenue fund in payment of any claim or demand upon said fund for the payment of which the legislature has made or hereafter may make an appropriation, and to pay interest on such warrants until the state treasury can redeem the same, at a rate not exceeding six (6) per cent. per annum. *Provided*, That the amount of such warrants outstanding at any time shall not exceed one hundred thousand (100,000) dollars.

SEC. 2. That the sum of six thousand (6,000) dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby annu-

ally appropriated from the general revenue fund for the purpose of paying interest on loans provided for in section one (1) of this act.

CHAPTER 216.

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY TO CARRY OUT THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION FIFTEEN (15) OF CHAPTER ONE HUNDRED AND THIRTY-TWO (132) OF THE GENERAL LAWS OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-THREE (1883) RELATING TO INFECTIOUS DISEASES.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated out of the general revenue fund of the state, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of five hundred dollars (\$500), to be used in carrying out the provisions of section fifteen (15) of chapter one hundred and thirty-two (132) of the general laws of one thousand eight hundred and eighty-five (1885) in cases where, under the provisions of said section, the state becomes liable. No money shall be paid out of this fund except upon duly certified statements of the expenses incurred, approved by the state board of health and also approved by the governor.
