AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY FOR THE SUPPORT OF STATE TEACHERS' INSTITUTES.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That the sum of one thousand dollars, for teachers institutes. (\$1,000) in addition to the sum now allowed by law, be appropriated for the year one thousand eight hundred and eighty-seven (1887) and annually thereafter, out of any moneys not otherwise appropriated, for defraying the current expenses of state teachers' institutes, and for institutes of instruction in normal methods in the elementary departments of graded schools, under the direction of the superintendent of public instruction.

This act shall take effect and be in force from When act to Sec. 2. and after its passage.

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY TO REIMBURSE ERN-EST A. URNLAND, CHARLES M. SHELDON, NICHOLAS LAUSEN, AND GEORGE F. URNLAND FOR THE CARE AND SUPPORT AND MONEY FURNISHED IN TAKING CARE OF JOHN W. CARLSON, A NON-RESIDENT PAUPER.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesoto:

SECTION 1. That the sum of of five hundred (500) dollars be and the same is hereby appropriated out of any money in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of paying and reimbursing Ernest A. Urnland, Charles M. Sheldon, Nicholas Lausen, and George F. Urnland, for the care and support, and for money expended in taking care of John W. Carlson, a non-resident pauper.
