AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY FOR THE SUPPORT OF OF THE STATE REFORM SCHOOL.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Appropriations for state reform school. Section 1. That the following sums of money, or so much thereof as may be necessary, be and the same are hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the state treasury belonging to the state institute fund not otherwise appropriated, for the following purposes:

First, for the current expenses of the state reform school for the year eighteen hundred and eighty-seven, (1887)

forty thousand dollars (\$40,000).

Second, for the correct expenses of the state reform school for the year eighteen hundred and eighty-eight, (1888)

forty thousand dollars (\$40,000).

Third, for repairs and improvements of the state reform school buildings and grounds for the year eighteen hundred and eighty-eight (1888), two thousand dollars (\$2,000).

Fourth, for repairs and improvements of the state reform school buildings and grounds for the year eighteen hundred and eighty-nine (1889), two thousand dollars

(\$2,000).

When act to take effect.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

AN ACT TO REIMBURSE DANIEL F. AKIN FOR EXPENSES INCURRED IN A CONTESTED ELECTION.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Reimburses Daniel F.Akin. SECTION 1. That the sum of nine hundred and thirty-seven and fifty one-hundredths (937.50) dollars be and the same is hereby appropriated out of anymoneys in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated, to reimburse Daniel F. Akin for moneys by him expended in the case of Truax
