

## CHAPTER 238.

[S. F. No. 585.]

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY FOR THE PAYMENT OF THE EXPENSES OF THE STATE PRISON FOR THE FISCAL YEARS ENDING JULY THIRTY-FIRST (31st), ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-EIGHT (1888), AND JULY THIRTY-FIRST (31st), ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-NINE (1889).

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota*

SECTION 1. That the sum of seventy-three thousand (73,000) dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary, be and the same is hereby appropriated from the general revenue fund for the payment of the expenses of the state prison at Stillwater for the fiscal year ending July thirty-first (31st), one thousand eight hundred and eighty-eight (1888).

SEC. 2. That the sum of seventy-five thousand (75,000) dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary, be and the same is hereby appropriated from the general revenue fund, for the payment of the expenses of the state prison at Stillwater, for the fiscal year ending July thirty-first (31st), one thousand eight hundred and eighty-nine (1889).

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER 239.

[S. F. No. 123.]

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY TO PAY FOR REPAIRING AND REBUILDING A PORTION OF THE BRIDGE ACROSS THE MISSISSIPPI RIVER AT THE VILLAGE OF SAUK RAPIDS, IN BENTON COUNTY, MINNESOTA.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

SECTION 1. Whereas, a portion of the bridge across the Mississippi river at the village of Sauk Rapids, in the county Benton, state of Minnesota, was in the month of April, A. D. one thousand eight hundred and eighty-five (1885), destroyed; and whereas, the portion of said bridge so destroyed has been rebuilt at a cost of four thousand six
