

CHAPTER 23.

(H. F. No. 80).

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION ONE HUNDRED AND FORTY-TWO (142), CHAPTER EIGHT (8), OF TITLE FOUR (4) OF THE GENERAL STATUTES OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-EIGHT (1878), RELATING TO SALARIES OF COUNTY AUDITORS.

Salaries of

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section one hundred and forty-two (142) of chapter eight (8) of title four (4) of the General Statutes of one thousand eight hundred and seventy-eight (1878), be and the same is hereby amended by striking out the word "eight" where it occurs on the twenty-fifth (25th) line of said section, and insert the word "six" in lieu thereof.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after the first (1st) day of April, one thousand eight hundred and eighty-seven (1887).

CHAPTER 24.

(H. F. No. 35).

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION TWO (2) OF CHAPTER TWO HUNDRED AND SIXTEEN (216) OF GENERAL LAWS OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-FIVE (1885), RELATING TO PRINTING DIGEST OF MINNESOTA REPORTS.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section two (2) of chapter two hundred and sixteen (216) of the General Laws of one thousand eight hundred and eighty-five (1885) be, and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

"Section 2. Said work shall be prepared by such persons and in such manner as the judges of the Supreme Court shall designate and approve;

Provided, that it shall be a full and complete index to volumes one (1) to thirty-four (34) inclusive of the Minnesota reports; shall be printed on paper equal to that used in the current volumes of Minnesota reports. and bound in

full law sheep binding, and shall be ready for delivery within nine (9) months from January first (1st), one thousand eight hundred and eighty-seven (1887).

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 25.

H. F. No. 624.1

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION TEN (10) OF CHAPTER SEVENTY-SIX (76) OF THE GENERAL STATUTES OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-EIGHT (1878), RELATING TO ACTIONS RESPECTING CORPORATIONS.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section ten (10) of chapter seventy-six (76) of the general statutes of A. D. one thousand eight hundred and seventy-eight (1878), be and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

“Upon a final judgment on any such complaint, the court shall cause a just and fair distribution of the property of all such corporations, and of the proceeds thereof, not distributed prior to the passage of this act, to be made in the following manner: After the payment of costs, debts due the United States, the State of Minnesota, all taxes or assignments levied and unpaid, expenses of the receivership and executing the trust, the receiver shall pay in full, if sufficient there remains for that purpose, the claims duly proven of all servants, clerks, or laborers for personal services or wages owing from such corporation, for services performed for the three (3) months preceding the appointment of a receiver of such corporation as provided in section nine (9), and the balance of said estate shall then be distributed among the general creditors of such corporation under the direction of the court.
