## CHAPTER 241.

[S. F. No 629.]

AN ACT TO INCREASE THE STANDING APPROPRIATIONS, AND TO PROVIDE FOR THE CURRENT EXPENSES OF THE STATE NORMAL SCHOOL AT MOORHEAD.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Appropriation for state normal school at Moorhead.

Section 1. That the sum of five thousand (5,000) dollars is hereby appropriated out of any money in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated, for defraying the current expenses of the State Normal School at Moorhead, for the year one thousand eight hundred and eighty-eight (1888), and an equal sum annually thereafter, all of said moneys to be expended under the direction of the state normal board.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER 242.

[S. F. No. 59.]

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY FOR THE ERECTION OF A BUILDING FOR THE STATE NORMAL SCHOOL AT MOORHEAD.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Appropriation for building normal school at Moorhead. Section 1. The sum of sixty thousand (60,000) dollars is hereby appropriated out of any money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated to be expended in the erection of a building for the State Normal School at Moorhead. The same is to be paid on warrants drawn by the president of the state normal school board and countersigned by the secretary thereof. Upon the presentation of such warrants to the state auditor, he shall allow warrants on the state treasurer for the amount named in the warrants of the said president and secretary, not exceeding the sum of sixty thousand (60,000) dollars aforesaid, and the said money so drawn shall be expended for the erection of said normal school building under the direction of said normal board.

The said normal board shall as soon as practicable after the passage of this act, erect or contract for the erection of a good, suitable and substantial building for said normal school at Moorhead, upon the site provided for and now owned by the state. Provided, however, That said normal board shall have no power or authority to erect or contract for the erection of any building for said state normal school, so that the same when fully completed in every part thereof, shall have cost the state a sum greater than sixty thousand (60,000) dollars.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from when act to

and after its passage.

## CHAPTER 243

[S. F. No. 182.]

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY FOR THE COMPLETION AND ERECTION OF ADDITIONAL BUILDINGS FOR THE PURCHASE OF ADDITIONAL LAND AND FOR IMPROVE-MENTS FOR THE IMBECILE DEPARTMENT OF THE MINNESOTA INSTITUTE FOR THE DEAF AND DUMB AND BLIND.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That the sum of seventeen thousand five hundred (17,500) dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated, to be drawn and expended during the fiscal year ending July thirty-first (31st), one thousand eight hundred and eighty-seven (1887), for the school for idiots and imbeciles at Faribault, for the following purposes, to-wit:

For completing the building now under contract, three

thousand dollars (\$3,000).

For building boiler house, smoke stack, and addition to the kitchen, three thousand five hundred dollars (\$3,500).

For laundry, and machinery, and grading, one thousand five hundred dollars (\$1,500).

For steam heating and plumbing, seven thousand dollars (\$7,000).

For additional thirty acres of land, two thousand five hundred (\$2,500).
