CHAPTER 245.

[S. F. No. 363.]

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY FOR HOSPITALS FOR INSANE ACCOUNT, AND FOR THE PURPOSES THEREIN NAMED.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the following sums of money, or so Appropriations much thereof as may be necessary, be and the same hereby for the hospitals for insanc. is appropriated out of any money in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated, for the following purposes.

For the hospital for the insane at St. Peter, to be drawn

from the revenue fund—

First—For right of way for railroad side track, one thousand dollars (\$1,000).

Second—For new kitchen two thousand dollars (\$2,000).

Third—For steward's office, store room and coal storage, five thousand five hundred dollars (\$5,500).

Fourth—For new water mains, three thousand dollars

That items first, second, third, and fourth shall be payable during the fiscal year ending July thirty-first (31st), one thousand eight hundred and eighty-seven (1887).

for the hospi-tals for insane.

For the support of said insane hospital at St. Peter for the fiscal year ending July thirty-first (31st), one thousand eight hundred and eighty-eight (1888), the sum of one hundred and sixty-three thousand eight hundred dollars (\$163,800).

And for like support for the fiscal year ending July thirty-first (31st), one thousand eight hundred and eightynine (1889), the sum of one hundred and sixty-three thou-

sand eight hundred dollars (\$163,800).

For second hospital for insane at Rochester, to be drawn from the revenue fund—

First—For blacksmith shop and coke house, five hundred

dollars (\$500).

Second—For making dam and bridge and opening streets, seven hundred and fifty dollars (\$750).

Third—For additional sewer and extension of water pipes and hydrants, one thousand five hundred dollars (\$1,500).

Fourth-For enlarging kitchen, two thousand dollars

(\$2.000.)

All of the last four (4) mentioned items to be payable during the fiscal year ending July thirty-first (31st), one thousand eight hundred and eighty-seven (1887).

Fifth-For gymnasium and amusement hall, one thou-

sand five hundred dollars (\$1,500).

Said last item to be payable during the fiscal year ending July thirty-first (31st), one thousand eight hundred and

eighty-eight (1888).

Sixth—For a double detached ward payable during the fiscal year ending July thirty-first (31st), one thousand eight hundred and eighty-nine (1889), fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000).

For the support of the insane hospital at Rochester for the fiscal year ending July thirty-first (31st), one thousand eight hundred and eighty-eight (1888), the sum of one hundred and thirty-one thousand and forty dollars (\$131,040).

And for like support for the fiscal year ending July thirty-first (31st), one thousand eight hundred and eightynine (1889), the further sum of one hundred and thirty-one

thousand and forty dollars (\$131,040).

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
