

CHAPTER 246.

[S. F. No. 66.]

**AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY FOR THE STATE
PUBLIC SCHOOL.***Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota.*

SECTION 1. That the following sums of money be and the same hereby are appropriated out of any money in the state treasury belonging to the general revenue fund, or which may be placed to the credit of said fund during the fiscal year ending August first (1st), one thousand eight hundred and eighty-seven (1887), for the following purposes: For refunding money advanced by citizens of Owatonna to furnish and defray the current expenses of said school, the sum of five thousand (5,000) dollars. For deficiency and contingent expenses, the sum of three thousand (3,000) dollars. For defraying the current expenses of said school during the fiscal year ending August first (1st), one thousand eight hundred and eighty-seven (1887), seven thousand (7,000) dollars.

CHAPTER 247.

**AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY IN ADDITION TO THE IN-
COME OF THE PERMANENT UNIVERSITY FUND FOR
THE SUPPORT OF THE STATE UNIVERSITY.***Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

SECTION 1. That the sum of fifty thousand (50,000) dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary, be and the same is hereby appropriated, in addition to the income of the permanent university fund, from the general revenue fund for the support of the state university for the fiscal year ending July thirty-one (31), one thousand eight hundred and eighty-one (1888), and annually thereafter.
