

## CHAPTER 248.

[S. F. No. 491.]

AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE REPRESENTATION OF THE MINNESOTA NATIONAL GUARD AT THE NATIONAL GUARD ENCAMPMENT, TO BE HELD IN WASHINGTON, D. C., IN MAY, ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-SEVEN (1887).

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota.*

National guard  
at Washington.

SECTION 1. That the governor and commander-in-chief is hereby instructed to detail one of the companies of the Minnesota National Guard to represent the state of Minnesota at the National Guard encampment to be held at Washington, D. C., May twenty-third (23d) to thirtieth (30th), one thousand eight hundred and eighty-seven (1887), inclusive.

Appropriation.

SEC. 2. That the sum of one thousand (1,000) dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated to pay for the transportation and subsistence of said company on said trip.

When set to  
take effect.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
