AN ACT FOR THE RELIEF OF ADOLPH WOLFF, AND TO APPROPRIATE MONEY THEREFOR.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. The sum of two thousand (2,000) dollars be and the same is hereby appropriated out of any money in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated for the relief of Adolph Wolff, who was injured by the fall of a stone upon his shoulder during the construction of the state capitol, while in the employ of the state of Minnesota.

CHAPTER 252.

AN ACT TO FIX THE SALARY OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL'S ASSISTANT OR CLERK.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That sub-division twenty-one (21) of section one (1) of chapter seven (7) of the general statutes of A. D. one thousand eight hundred and seventy-eight (1878) as amended by section one (1) of chapter forty-nine (49) of the general laws of the year one thousand eight hundred and eighty-one (1881), "Extra Session," be and the same is hereby amended by striking out the word "twelve" and inserting the word "fifteen" in lieu thereof.

SEC. 2. That sub-division twenty-two (22) of section ten (10) of said chapter seven (7), as amended by section two (2) of said chapter forty-nine (49), be and the same is hereby amended by striking out the word "twelve" and inserting the word "eighteen" in lieu thereof.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
