

CHAPTER 44.

(S. F. No. 417).

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION SIX (6) OF CHAPTER ONE HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-SEVEN (187), GENERAL LAWS OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-FIVE (1885), RELATING TO SUPPORT OF FIRE DEPARTMENTS.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Fire department relief associations.

SECTION 1. That section six (6) of chapter one hundred and eighty-seven (187) of the General Laws of one thousand eight hundred and eighty-five (1885), be and the same hereby is amended by adding at the end thereof the following:

Provided, That the pro rata proportion of the amounts due cities of ten thousand (10,000) population and upwards to be paid to the treasurers of incorporated relief associations of said cities instead of to the officers as specified in section five (5) of said laws. And the money thus paid shall be expended solely for the support and the relief of sick, injured or disabled firemen and their widows and orphans, and not for the purpose of equipment, or maintenance of any fire department whatever. And this amendment shall in no wise interfere with the purposes of the law, relating to cities, towns, and villages of a less population than ten thousand (10,000).

When act to take effect.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 45.

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION FIFTY-FIVE (55) CHAPTER THIRTEEN (13) GENERAL STATUTES ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-EIGHT (1878), RELATING TO ROADS, CARTWAYS AND BRIDGES.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That Section fifty-five (55) of Chapter thirteen (13) general statutes of one thousand eight hundred and seventy eight (1878) be amended [so as to read as follows:
