

## CHAPTER 94.

[S. F. No. 558.]

AN ACT TO AMEND CHAPTER ONE HUNDRED AND SIXTY-SIX (166) OF THE GENERAL LAWS OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-THREE (1883), APPROPRIATING MONEY FOR THE PERMANENT IMPROVEMENT FOR THE MINNESOTA STATE PRISON.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota.*

Section 1. That section one (1) of chapter one hundred and sixty-six (166) of the general laws of one thousand eight hundred and eighty-three (1883), entitled "An Act to make appropriation for permanent improvement for the Minnesota State Prison" be, and the same is, hereby amended by adding thereto the following:

"*Provided*, That said building committee are authorized to expend from the appropriation made by this chapter for the year one thousand eight hundred and eighty-seven (1887), the following sums for the purposes herein named:

"For the purchase of a house and grounds outside of the present prison grounds, to be used as a residence for the deputy warden, the sum of five thousand dollars (\$5,000), or so much thereof as may be necessary, and the sum of fifteen hundred dollars (\$1500), or so much thereof as may be necessary, to enable the Inspectors to pay the Northwestern Manufacturing and Car Company the amounts provided for by chapter two hundred and eighty-four (284) of the general laws of one thousand eight hundred and eighty-five (1885)."
