

CHAPTER 102.

AN ACT TO AMEND AN ACT ENTITLED "AN ACT TO CONSTITUTE AND ESTABLISH A SCHOOL DISTRICT IN THE COUNTY OF WABASHA.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section one (1) of chapter one hundred and twenty-eight (128), of the special laws of the extra session of the year one thousand eight hundred and eighty-one (1881), be and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows, to-wit:

Section 1. That the following described territory in the township of Plainview, Wabasha county, Minnesota, to-wit: Sections number six (6), seven (7), eight (8), sixteen (16), seventeen (17), eighteen (18), the west half ($w\frac{1}{2}$) and the south-west fourth ($sw\frac{1}{4}$) of the south-east fourth ($se\frac{1}{4}$) of section five (5), all of section nine (9), except the north-east quarter ($ne\frac{1}{4}$) thereof, all in township number one hundred and eight (108), north of range number eleven (11) west, be and is hereby established and incorporated into a school district to be known and described as the Plainview school district, and as such corporation under the name and style aforesaid shall have and enjoy all the powers, rights and privileges of any school district organized under the general laws of this state.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and, be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 103.

AN ACT TO AMEND CHAPTER ONE HUNDRED AND SIXTEEN (116) OF THE SPECIAL LAWS OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY (1870).

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. Section one (1) of an act entitled "an act to amend an act entitled an act to organize the Saint Croix Boom Corporation, passed and approved February twenty-seventh (27th) A. D. one thousand eight hundred and fifty-six (1856), "approved February twenty-eighth (28th) A.D. one thousand eight hundred and seventy (1870) and being chapter one hundred and sixteen (116) of the special laws of one

thousand eight hundred and seventy (1870), be and the same is hereby amended by adding thereto the following: And said corporation is hereby authorized and empowered to grant, bargain, sell, demise, lease or let to any person or persons, firm or corporation its property of every name or nature, or any part or portion thereof, or all or any part of its franchises conferred by this act or otherwise, for such length of time during its existence, as above limited, and upon such terms as may be agreed upon by the parties thereto. And any such lease that may heretofore have been made by said corporation is hereby expressly legalized and confirmed.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 104.

AN ACT TO AMEND CHAPTER FORTY (40) OF SPECIAL LAWS OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE (1881), AND AMENDMENTS THERETO RELATING TO THE VILLAGE OF RED LAKE FALLS.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the act entitled an act to incorporate the village of Red Lake Falls, in Polk county, approved February twenty-eight (28), A. D., one thousand eight hundred and eighty-one (1881), and the amendments thereto, be amended by adding to and altering the same in the manner following, to wit:

SEC. 2. That the limits of said village of Red Lake Falls as described in section one (1) of said act, and in section two (2) in the amendment of said act, approved March fifth (5th), one thousand eight hundred and eighty-five (1885), be and the same are hereby extended by including therein and adding thereto the northeast quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$), section twenty-eight (28), township number one hundred and fifty-one (151), range forty-four (44).

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
