AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF MADISON TO USE THE VILLAGE FUNDS FOR THE PURPOSE OF MOVING AND REPAIRING THE COURT HOUSE AND JAIL.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota.

Section 1. That it shall be lawful for the village council of the village of Madison to appropriate not to exceed five hundred (500) dollars from the village treasury for the purpose of defraying in part, the expense of moving and re-creating the Lac Qui Parle county court house and jail.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after

its passage.

CHAPTER 245.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF HENNE-PIN COUNTY MINNESOTA, TO PAY SAMUEL J. BARLOW ONE HUN-DRED (100) DOLLARS TO REIMBURSE HIM FOR MONEY AND TIME SPENT IN HIS CONTEST WITH H. W. BRAZIE FOR THE OFFICE OF COUNTY COMMISSIONER OF THE THIRD (3D) COMMISSIONER DIS-TRICT OF HENNEPIN COUNTY.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That the county commissioners of Hennepin county, Minnesota, are hereby authorized to pay to Samuel J. Barlow the sum of one hundred (100) dollars out of any money applicable for that purpose, to reimburse said Samuel J. Barlow for money and time spent by him in his contest with H.W. Brazie in November one thousand eight hundred and eighty-six (1886) for the office of county commissioner of the third (3d) commissioner district of said Hennepin county.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after

its passage.
