CHAPTER 254.

[H. F. No. 429]

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF POPE COUNTY TO APPROPRIATE MONEY TO THE POPE COUNTY AGRICULTURAL SOCIETY.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. The board of county commissioners of Pope county is hereby authorized to appropriate such sum or sums of money out of the revenue fund of said county to the Pope County Agricultural Society, as they may deem proper, to aid said society in the purchase of fair grounds, paying of premiums and other necessary expenses. *Provided*, that no part of such money so appropriated shall be used in the payment of compensation to any of the officers of said society, nor the payment of premiums for horse-racing.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 255.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING AND REQUIRING EACH TOWNSHIP IN WADENA COUNTY TO SUPPORT ITS OWN POOR.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That each township in the county of Wadena, shall support all the poor persons in the town, and the board of supervisors of each town in said county shall have entire and exclusive superintendence of the poor of their respective towns.

SEC. 2. The electors of each town in said county shall at their annual town meetings in each year, vote to raise such sum of money for the support of the poor as they may deem expedient, which facts
