SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 268.

AN ACT TO AMEND AN ACT ENTITLED "AN ACT FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT AND BETTER REGULATION OF COMMON SCHOOLS OF ST. CHARLES, THE SAME BEING DESIGNATED AS SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. SIXTY (60) IN WINONA COUNTY," BEING CHAPTER NINETY-NINE (99) OF THE SPECIAL LAWS OF EIGHTEEN HUNDRED AND SIXTY-SEVEN (1867.)

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. Section two (2) of chapter ninety-nine (99) of the special laws of one thousand eight hundred and sixty-seven (1867) is hereby amended so as to read as follows: The officers of said district shall constitute a board of education, and shall consist of six (6) members, who shall be elected on the last Saturday of March next after the passage of this act, two (2) of whom shall hold their offices for three (3) years, and two (2) for two (2) years, and two (2) for one (1) year, and annually thereafter, upon the third Saturday of July there shall be elected two (2) members who shall hold their offices for the term of three (3) years. No member shall be entitled to receive any compensation for services except the clerk, whose compensation shall be fixed by the board.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
