

## CHAPTER 269.

[H. F. No. 845.]

AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE ABOLISHMENT AND SUBDIVISION OF THE INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT OF PLEASANT GROVE, IN OLMTSTED COUNTY.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

SECTION 1. That the county commissioners of the county of Olmsted, state of Minnesota, are hereby authorized, on a favorable vote therefor, as hereinafter provided, to abolish the independent school district of Pleasant Grove, in said county, and subdivide the same into and form six (6) common school districts, as nearly equal in extent as may be, and so that there shall be a school house in each of such districts, and a suitable proportion of the school funds and other school property shall be apportioned to each district so formed.

SEC. 2. That the proposition for the abolishment and division of such independent school district shall be submitted to the legal voters resident in said district, at a special meeting to be called for that purpose, which meeting shall be called and notice thereof given, and the same shall be organized in the manner provided by law for the calling and holding of meetings for organization of independent school districts. The ballots cast at said election, by electors voting in favor of said proposition, shall have written or printed, or partly written and partly printed thereon, the words, "Abolishment and subdivision of district—Yes"; and the ballots cast at said election by electors voting against said proposition, shall have written or printed, or partly written and partly printed thereon, the words, "Abolishment and subdivision of district—No".

SEC. 3. The votes cast at such election shall be received and canvassed by the judges of election, and returned by them to the county auditor within five days after such election. If a majority of the votes so cast shall be in favor of said proposition, the county commissioners of said county shall at any duly called meeting, proceed to subdivide said district, as hereinbefore provided, and if a majority of the votes so cast shall be against said proposition, the said county commissioners shall take no action in said matter, and said district shall continue its organization as heretofore.

SEC. 4. Nothing in this act shall be construed as in any manner affecting any independent obligation or contract of any kind existing against or with said independent school district of Pleasant Grove.

SEC. 5. All acts or parts of acts inconsistent with this act, are hereby repealed.

SEC. 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
