and poles to be taken down and removed from the streets and alleys, and may provide for the arrest and punishment of any person who shall refuse or neglect to take down and remove any such wire or poles when so required; and in case of the neglect of any person to take down and remove any such wire or poles after being so required the common council may cause the same to be done by the police or

otherwise at the cost and expense of the owner thereof.

SEC. 7. The said corporation is hereby invested with all the powers necessary to carry into full force, virtue and effect, all and every part of this act, and the acts amendatory thereof; and the common council of the said village shall have full power and authority to enforce all the provisions of this act and all the power and authority herein granted to the said common council or to the several officers of the said village, by the infliction of fines, penalties and forfeitures

not exceeding the limit herein prescribed.

SEC 8. In all respects not herein provided for, the said village

shall be and continue part of the township of Litchfield.

SEC. 9. All ordinances, rules, by-laws and resolutions heretofore made and established by the common council of the said village, not inconsistent with this act, shall be and remain in force until altered

or repealed by the common council.

SEC. 10. The village officers at present holding office in the said village, shall continue to hold their respective offices, and exercise the powers and discharge the duties thereof until the expiration of their several terms of office, in all respects as if this act had not been passed; and the said village shall, until the annual election to be held on the first (1st) Monday in April, A. D. one thousand eight hundred and eighty-seven (1887), be governed by the laws heretofore in force relative to the said village, in all respects, except that the common council shall divide the said village into wards, and appoint the judges of election in the several wards, as herein provid d.

Sec. 2. That this act shall take effect and be in force from and

after its approval.

CHAPTER 28.

(S. F. No. 644.)

AN ACT TO AMEND THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Amend section ten (10), chapter ten (10) of the charter of the city of Austin by inserting the words "or maintain" after the word "build" whenever it occurs in the proviso at the end of said section.

S.c. 2. This act to take effect immediately.
