CHAPTER 281.

(H. F. No. 772.)

AN ACT TO CHANGE THE BOUNDARY OF SCHOOL DISTRICTS IN FARIBAULT COUNTY.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota.

SECTION 1. That the south one-half $(\frac{1}{3})$ of south east one-quarter $(\frac{1}{4})$, section one (1), township one hundred and three (103) north, of range twenty-eight (28) west, be and the same is hereby detached from school district number seven (7) of Faribault county, and attached to school district number thirteen (13) of the said county.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 282.

AN ACT TO DETACH CERTAIN TERRITORY FROM INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT NUMBER ONE (1) IN THE COUNTY OF RED. WOOD.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the following described territory, commencing at the southwest corner of the south-east quarter $(\frac{1}{4})$ of the northwest quarter $(\frac{1}{4})$ of section eleven (11), in township one hundred and twelve (112), of range thirty-six (36), and thence running north one hundred and sixty (160) rods, thence east to the center of Redwood river, thence down said river in a southeasterly direction to a point twenty (20) rods west of the east line of the southwest quarter $(\frac{1}{4})$ of section two (2), in township one hundred and twelve (112), of range thirty-six (36) thence south to a point sixty (60) rods east of the place of beginning, thence west sixty (60) rods to the place of beginning, being parts of sections two (2) and eleven (11), in township one hundred and twelve (112), range thirty-six (36), in Redwood county, be, and the same is hereby detached from Independent School District number one (1) in Redwood county.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
