## CHAPTER 297.

(H. F. No. 878.)

TO LEGALIZE THE ORGANIZATION AND INCORPORATION OF THE PARKERS PRAIRIE CEMETERY ASSOCIATION, AND TO LEGALIZE THE OFFICIAL ACTS OF ALL THE OFFICERS OF SUCH ASSOCIATION.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That the incorporation and organization of the Parkers Prairie Cemetery Association of the town of Parkers Prairie, in the county of Otter Tail, and State of Minnesota, be and the same is hereby legalized, and that all the official acts of the respective officers of such association are hereby legalized and declared valid in all respects, the same as though said Parkers Prairie Cemetary Association had been legally incorporated.

Sec. 2. That from and after the passage of this act, the said

SEC. 2. That from and after the passage of this act, the said Parkers' Prairie Cemetery Association shall transact all its business, and do and perform all and singular its duties as such association under and pursuant to the general laws of the state of Minnesota,

governing cemetery associations.

Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER 298.

[S. F. No. 418]

AN ACT TO REPEAL CHAPTER ONE HUNDRED AND NINETY-SEVEN (197) OF THE SPECIAL LAWS OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-NINE (1879), IN RELATION TO SALARIES OF AUDITOR'S CLERKS OF LESUEUR COUNTY, MINNESOTA.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That chapter one hundred and ninety-seven (197) of the special laws of one thousand eight hundred and seventy-nine (1879), be and the same is hereby repealed.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after
