

CHAPTER 302.

[H. F. No. 911.]

AN ACT TO REPEAL SECTION EIGHT (8) OF CHAPTER THIRTY-THREE OF SPECIAL LAWS OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE (1881), AND TO SEPARATE THE TERRITORY COMPRISED WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF THE CITY OF ORTONVILLE FROM THE TOWNSHIP OF ORTONVILLE, BIG STONE COUNTY, FOR ALL CORPORATE PURPOSES.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section eight of chapter thirty-three (33), of the special laws of 1881, incorporating the city of Ortonville, in the counties of Big Stone and Lacqui Parle, be and the same is hereby repealed.

SEC. 2. That the territory comprised within the city limits of said city of Ortonville, as described by said chapter thirty-three (33), be and the same hereby is separated and set apart from said township of Ortonville, Big Stone county, and declared to be a separate and distinct corporation for all corporate purposes.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval.

CHAPTER 303.

(H. F. No. 752.)

AN ACT TO REPEAL SECTION TWO (2) OF CHAPTER THREE HUNDRED AND FIVE (305), SPECIAL LAWS OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-NINE (1879), RELATING TO THE FEES OF THE REGISTER OF DEEDS OF OLMSTED COUNTY.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section two (2), of chapter three hundred and five (305), of the special laws of one thousand eight hundred and seventy-nine (1879), be and the same hereby is repealed.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
