

CHAPTER 328.

[S. F. No. 156.]

AN ACT TO DETACH CERTAIN TERRITORY FROM THE BOROUGH OF BELLE PLAINE, SCOTT COUNTY, AND TO CREATE THEREFROM A NEW ELECTION DISTRICT.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That all of township one hundred and thirteen (113), range twenty-four (24) west, and also sections twelve (12), thirteen (13), twenty-four (24), twenty-five (25) and thirty-six (36), in township one hundred and thirteen (113), range twenty-five (25), except the part thereof now belonging to and being contained in the borough of Belle Plaine, shall be detached from the said borough of Belle Plaine for election purposes, and constitute a separate election district or precinct.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 329.

AN ACT TO EXTEND THE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF NEW RICHLAND, IN THE COUNTY OF WASECA, AND TO ATTACH CERTAIN TERRITORY TO SAID VILLAGE.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That all that territory included in the plat of Zeizer's second addition to the village of New Richland, in the county of Waseca, Minnesota, and heretofore laid out and platted into lots and blocks, and the plat thereof filed in the office of the register of deeds of said county of Waseca, on the 17th day of May, 1886, by Wilhimine Zeizer, except the north one-half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of block three (3) and the north half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of block four (4), be and the same is hereby annexed to and made a part of the incorporated village of New Richland, in said county of Waseca.

SEC. 2. The territory hereby added to said corporation of said village of New Richland shall hereafter be subject to the jurisdiction, laws and ordinances, now or hereafter in force in said village.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
