SPECIAL LAWS

CHAPTER 330.

AN ACT TO CHANGE THE NAME OF THE MINNESOTA ACADEMY, TO PILLSBURY ACADEMY.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota.

SECTION 1. That the name of the Minnesota Academy located in the city of Owatonna be and the same is hereby changed to Pillsbury Academy.

SEC. 2. The change in said name shall in no manner effect the rights, privileges or property of said corporation.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the Governor.

CHAPTER 331.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING AND REQUIRING THE REGISTER OF DEEDS OF FREEBORN COUNTY TO RECORD THE PLAT OF MORIN'S ADDI-TION TO THE CITY OF ALBERT LEA.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the register of deeds in and for the county of Freeborn be authorized and required to record the plat of Morin's addition to the city of Albert Lea, county of Freeborn, state of Minnesota, without the auditor's certificate of said county, relative to taxes.

SEC. 2. Said plat is contained in the following Government land divisions, to wit: The west one-half $(\frac{1}{2})$ of the south-east quarter $(\frac{1}{4})$, and the east one-half $(\frac{1}{2})$ of the south-west quarter $(\frac{1}{4})$ of section eight (8) township one hundred and two (102), range twenty-one (21) west, and the north one-half $(\frac{1}{2})$ of the north-east quarter $(\frac{1}{4})$ of section seventeen (17), township one hundred and two (102), range twenty-one (21) west, all of said land lying and being in the incorporate limits of the said city of Albert Lea.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
