SEC. 2. Any person who shall violate the provisions of this act shall be guilty of misdemeaner, and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine of not less than ten (\$10) nor more than twenty-five (\$25) dollars, and be committed to the county jail until such fine and costs are paid; such commitment, however, not to exceed ten (10) days.

SEC. 3. All proceedings under this act shall be commenced within sixty (60) days from the time such offences were committed, and shall be brought in the same manner as provided by law in similar cases, and all fines imposed and collected under this act shall be paid into the treasury of said Carver county for the use of the public schools

in said county.

SEC. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 339.

[S. F. No. 519.]

AN ACT REGULATING THE COMPENSATION OF THE COUNTY COM-MISSIONERS OF McLEOD COUNTY.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. The county commissioners of the county of McLeod shall each receive three dollars (\$3.00) per day for each day necessarily employed in the discharge of official duty and ten (10) cents per mile for every mile traveled in the performance of such duty, the mileage so traveled to be computed by the nearest traveled route; but no commissioner of said county shall receive pay for more than forty (40) days in any one (1) year.

Sec. 2. All acts or parts of acts inconsistent with the provisions of this act, so far as the same apply to the county of McLeod, be and

the same are hereby repealed.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
