SPECIAL LAWS

SEC. 5. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with this act in so far as relates to Le Sueur county is concerned, are hereby repealed.

SEC. 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 354.

[H. F. No. 577.]

AN ACT TO PRESCRIBE THE MANNER OF CATCHING FISH IN OTTER TAIL COUNTY.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. No person shall at any time take, catch or kill any fish of any kind, except sturgeon, from any of the waters of the county of Otter Tail, in this state, in any other manner than by angling for them with a hook and line.

SEC. 2. Any person violating any of the provisions of this act shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and on conviction therefor shall be fined not less than ten dollars (\$10) nor more than fifty dollars (\$50) for each and every offense.

SEC. 3. It shall be the duty of the chairman of the board of supervisors of each and every town in said county to prosecute all offenses arising in his town under the provisions of this act.

SEC. 4. All prosecutions for offenses under this act shall, except as hereinbefore otherwise provided, conform to the provisions of the general statutes of this state.

SEC. 5. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

SEC. 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
