

**CHAPTER 369.**

[H. F. No. 32.]

**AN ACT TO FIX THE COMPENSATION OF CERTAIN COUNTY OFFICERS OF HENNEPIN COUNTY.***Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

SECTION 1. The salary of the county attorney of Hennepin county shall be three thousand two hundred dollars (\$3,200), to be paid in the manner now required by law.

SEC. 2. The salary of the assistant county attorney of Hennepin county shall be one thousand eight hundred dollars (\$1,800) to be paid in the manner now required by law.

SEC. 3. All acts or parts of acts inconsistent with this act are hereby repealed.

SEC. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

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**CHAPTER 370..**

**AN ACT IN RELATION TO SLAUGHTERING AND RENDERING ESTABLISHMENTS IN THE SEVENTH WARD OF THE CITY OF SAINT PAUL.***Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

SECTION 1. That after the first (1st) day of April, one thousand eight hundred and eighty-seven (1887), no slaughtering or rendering establishment shall be suffered or permitted within the seventh (7th) ward of the city of Saint Paul, north of St. Clair street, in said ward, as said ward was constituted and organized February first (1st) eighteen hundred and eighty-seven (1887), nor shall any slaughtering or rendering by butchers, or others be suffered or permitted within said ward, north of said Saint Clair street, and any person who shall establish or maintain a rendering or slaughtering establishment, and any butcher or other person who shall render or carry on the business of slaughtering in said ward, north of Saint Clair street, is guilty of a misdemeanor, and shall be subject to the same punishment as is now prescribed by the criminal code of the state for misdemeanors.

SEC. 2. This act shall not affect any existing establishment or any person now engaged in the business described in this act within the territory defined in section one (1) of this act, until the city of Saint Paul shall have paid, or caused to be paid, to the persons owning such establishments, and carrying on such business, the damages suffered by such persons by the operation of this act, such damages to be ascertained and paid in the manner now prescribed by law for the ascertainment and payment of damages in the case of the condemnation of land for highway purposes, and the payment of damages therefor in the city of Saint Paul, nor until sixty (60) days after the payment of such damages.

SEC. 3. The city of Saint Paul is hereby authorized and empowered to pay the damages provided for in this act.

SEC. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

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## CHAPTER 371.

AN ACT TO CHANGE THE NAME OF FROG LAKE, IN STEVENS COUNTY, TO LAKE GORDER.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

SECTION 1. That the name of that certain lake in the county of Stevens, this state, known as Frog lake, be and the same is hereby changed to Lake Gorder.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

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## CHAPTER 372.

AN ACT TO SEPARATE THE TOWN OF LEROY FROM THE VILLAGE OF LEROY, MOWER COUNTY, MINNESOTA.

SECTION 1. That the territory known and designated as the township of Leroy, being township number one hundred and one (101) north, of range numbered fourteen (14) west P. M. in the
