

SEC. 2. Jurors' fees in said municipal court shall be one [1.] dollar per day in the trial of civil actions, but no party shall be entitled to a jury in any civil action, unless he shall demand the same, and shall pay in to court the fees of such jury for one (1) day's attendance, before the *venire* shall issue, and all the fees of a jury in any civil case in said court shall be taxed as costs against the unsuccessful party, and shall be included in the judgment, and shall be collected as other taxable costs. In case a jury is not demanded and the jury fee paid, as hereinbefore provided, the case shall be tried by the court without a jury.

SEC. 3. All acts and parts of acts conflicting with the provisions of this act are hereby repealed.

SEC. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 51.

AN ACT TO AMEND CHAPTER ONE HUNDRED AND SIXTY-SIX (166) SPECIAL LAWS OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-FIVE (1885), ENTITLED "AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY OF WINONA TO FUND TEMPORARY LOANS," APPROVED FEBRUARY TWENTY-FOURTH (24th), ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-FIVE (1885).

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section two [2] of an act entitled "an act to authorize the city of Winona to fund temporary loans," approved February twenty-fourth [24th], one thousand eight hundred and eighty-five [1885], be amended by striking out from said section the words, "at the city treasurer's office in said city", and inserting, in lieu thereof the words, "at the National Park Bank in the city of New York".

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
