A JOINT RESOLUTION RELATING TO THE ESTABLISHMENT OF AGRICULTURAL EXPERIMENTAL STATIONS, INTRODUCED BY MR. EMERY, AND ADOPTED FEBRUARY SECOND (2), ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-SEVEN, (1887).

Whereas, A bill to establish agricultural experiment stations, known as house bill No. two thousand nine hundred and thirty-three (2933), is now pending in the congress of the United States; therefore be it

Resolved, By the house of representatives, the senate concurring, of the state of Minnesota, that our senators and representatives in congress be, and they are hereby requested to give their active support to the bill now pending in congress, known as house file No. two thousand nine hundred and thirty-three (2933), a bill to establish agricultural experiment stations.

That a copy of the above resolution be sent by the secretary of

state to each of our senators and representatives in congress.
