## CHAPTER 108.

(H. F. No. 8.]

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION FIFTEEN (15) OF CHAPTER THREE (3), OF GENERAL STATUTES ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-EIGHT (1878), RELATING TO COMPENSATION OF MEMBERS OF TRE LEGISLA-TURE.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section fifteen (15) of chapter three Members of Legislature, (3) of general statutes one thousand eight hundred and compensation seventy-eight (1878), be and the same is hereby amended of. so as to read as follows:

"Section 15. The compensation of members of legislature, at every regular and extra session, shall be computed by including the first and last days of the session and every intervening day."

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from Whom set to and after its passage.

## CHAPTER 109.

[H. F. No. 99.]

AN ACT AMENDING SECTION TWO (2) OF CHAPTER SEV-ENTY-SEVEN (77) OF THE GENERAL STATUTES OF EIGHTEEN HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-EIGHT (1878), RE-LATING TO ACTIONS BY OR AGAINST EXECUTORS, AD-MINISTRATORS AND HEIRS.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That section two (2) of chapter seventy- Personal seven (77) of the general statutes of eighteen hundred and representatives of deceased and seventy-eight (1878) be and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

When death is caused by the wrongful act or omission of any party or corporation the personal representatives of the deceased may maintain an action, if he might have maintained an action had he lived, for an injury caused by the same act or omission, by which the death was caused; but the action shall be commenced within two 2) years after the act or omission by which the death was caused.
