

## CHAPTER 124.

[S. P. No. 42.]

AN ACT TO AMEND THE PROVISIO IN SUBDIVISION "A" OF SECTION ONE (1) OF CHAPTER TEN (10) OF THE GENERAL LAWS OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-SEVEN (1887), RELATING TO THE REGULATION OF COMMON CARRIERS.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

SECTION 1. That the proviso of subdivision "A" of section one (1) of chapter ten (10) of the general laws of one thousand eight hundred and eighty-seven (1887), be and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

Common carriers, provisions relating to.

*Provided,* That nothing in this act shall apply to the carriage, storage or handling by any common carrier of property free or at reduced rates for the United States or the state of Minnesota, or for any municipal government or corporation within the state, or for any charitable purpose, or to or from fairs or expositions for exhibition thereat (or stock for breeding purposes), or to the issuance of mileage, excursion or commutation passenger tickets, at rates made equal to all, or to transportation to stock shippers with cars; and nothing in the provisions of this act shall be construed to prohibit any common carrier from giving reduced rates to ministers of religion, sisters of charity, or to missionaries, or to students of any college or university or other institutions of learning of this state, or to children attending the Minnesota institute for defectives at Fairbault, or the school for indigent children at Owatonna, or from issuing passes for the free transportation of passengers subject to the provisions of this act.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
