

CHAPTER 134.

[H. F. No. 1307.]

AN ACT TO AMEND AN ACT ENTITLED AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE INCORPORATION OF VILLAGES AND TO DEFINE THEIR DUTIES AND POWERS AND TO REPEAL CERTAIN LAWS IN RELATION THERETO, BEING CHAPTER ONE HUNDRED AND FORTY-FIVE (145) OF THE GENERAL LAWS OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-FIVE (1885), SO THAT THE VILLAGE OF BROWNS VALLEY, TRAVERSE COUNTY, MINNESOTA, SHALL BE A SEPARATE ELECTION DISTRICT FOR ALL PURPOSES FROM THE TOWN IN WHICH IT IS LOCATED.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. Chapter one hundred and forty-five (145) of the general laws of one thousand eight hundred and eighty-five (1885), be amended so that the provisions thereof relating to election districts shall not apply to the village of Browns Valley, Traverse county, Minnesota, and that said village of Browns Valley shall be and constitute a separate election district for all election purposes from the town in which it is located, provided that all elections held in said village shall be subject to the provisions of said chapter one hundred and forty-five (145) relating to the election of village officers.

SEC. 2. All acts or portions of acts inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 135.

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION ONE (1) OF CHAPTER ONE HUNDRED AND THIRTY-SIX (136) OF THE GENERAL LAWS OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-FIVE (1885,) RELATING TO THE TIME OF HOLDING THE TERMS OF THE DISTRICT COURT IN FREEBORN COUNTY, IN THE TENTH JUDICIAL DISTRICT.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SEC. 1. That section one (1) of chapter one hundred and thirty-six (136) of the general laws of one thousand
