

thirty (30) days or more before such term and no venire for such jury shall be issued more than thirty (30) days prior to any term, but nothing herein shall be so construed as to prevent the issuance of a special venire for a trial jurors as now provided by law and the said court may issue such special venire in case of emergency or necessity, even after such order has been made.

SEC. 4. All acts or parts of acts inconsistent with this act are hereby repealed.

SEC. 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage. When act to take effect.

## CHAPTER 141.

[B. F. No. 67.]

AN ACT TO CHANGE THE TIME FOR HOLDING THE GENERAL TERMS OF THE DISTRICT COURT IN AND FOR THE COUNTY OF WADENA, IN THE FIFTEENTH (15th) JUDICIAL DISTRICT.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota.*

SECTION 1. That the general terms of the district court in and for the county of Wadena, in the fifteenth (15th) judicial district of the state of Minnesota, shall be held at the times following, viz: On the first Monday in June and the first Monday in December in each year. District court, twelfth district terms of

SEC. 2. That all writs, proofs, bonds, recognizances, continuances, notices and proceedings had, issued or returnable to the terms of court in and for said county as affixed by law prior to the passage of this act, shall be deemed and be construed as made, taken and returnable to the proper terms of court in said county as fixed by this act. Writs, processes, etc., when returnable.

SEC. 3. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with this act are hereby repealed.

SEC. 4. This act to take effect and be in force from and after its passage. When act to take effect.
