Section 1. That the following sums of money, or so much thereof as may be necessary, be and the same are hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the state treasury belonging to the state institute fund not otherwise appropriated, for the following purposes:

First. For the current expenses of the state reform school for the fiscal year eighteen hundred and eighty-eight (1888), forty thousand dollars (\$40,000).

Second. For the current expenses of the state reform school for the fiscal year eighteen hundred and eighty-nine (1889), forty thousand dollars (\$40,000).

Third. For repairs and improvements of the state reform school buildings and grounds for the year eighteen hundred and eighty-eight (1888), two thousand dollars (\$2,000).

Fourth. For repairs and improvements of the state reform school buildings and grounds for the year eighteen hundred and eighty-nine (1889) two thousand dollars (\$2,000).

## CHAPTER 276.

### AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY FOR THE EXPENSES OF THE PRESENT SESSION OF THE LEGISLATURE.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota;*

SECTION 1. That the sum of one hundred and twenty thousand (\$120,000) dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary, be and the same is hereby appropriated from the general revenue fund, for the payment of the per diem, mileage and other expenses of the members and officers of the legislature during the present session.
