

CHAPTER 286.

[S. F. No. 81.]

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY TO SUPPLY THE DEFICIENCY IN THE APPROPRIATION FOR SPECIAL AND CURRENT EXPENSES FOR THE STATE PUBLIC SCHOOLS.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Deficiency in

appropriation.

SECTION 1. That the sum of twenty-two thousand and fifty (22,050) dollars be and the same is hereby appropriated out of any money in the treasury, not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of supplying the deficiency in the appropriation for special purposes and for the current expenses of the state public school for the year eighteen hundred and eighty-nine (1889), ending July thirty-first (31st).

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 287.

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY FOR THE GENERAL EXPENSES OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES THEREIN NAMED, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JULY THIRTY-FIRST, (31ST), EIGHTEEN HUNDRED AND NINETY (1890), AND ANNUALLY THEREAFTER, AND TO APPROPRIATE MONEY FOR CERTAIN GENERAL EXPENSES, FOR THE FISCAL YEARS ENDING JULY THIRTY-FIRST (31ST), EIGHTEEN HUNDRED AND NINETY (1890), AND JULY THIRTY-FIRST (31ST), EIGHTEEN HUNDRED AND NINETY-ONE (1891).

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the following sums of money, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are hereby appropriated from any moneys in the state treasury belonging to the general revenue fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purposes herein named, for the fiscal year ending July
