THE COLLEGES ESTABLISHED IN THE SEVERAL
STATES UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF AN ACT APPROVED
JULY SECOND (2nd), EIGHTEEN HUNDRED AND SIXTYTWO (1862)," AND OF THE ACTS SUPPLEMENTARY
THERETO, APPROVED MARCH TWO (2), EIGHTEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-SEVEN (1887.)

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota;

Agricultural experiment stations, assent to grants of money.

Section 1. That the state of Minnesota does hereby assent to the grants of money authorized by an act of the congress of the United States, entitled "An act to establish agricultural experiment stations in connection with the colleges established in the several states," under the provisions of an act approved July second (2nd), one thousand eight hundred and sixty-two (1862), and of the acts supplementary thereto.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER 59.

AN ACT TO CEDE TO THE UNITED STATES JURISDICTION OVER CERTAIN TERRITORY IN THE CITY OF DULUTH, MINNESOTA, AND GRANTING THE CONSENT OF THE LEGISLATURE TO THE PURCHASE OF THE SAME BY THE UNITED STATES AS PROVIDED BY SECTION THREE HUNDRED AND FIFTY-FIVE (355) OF THE REVISED STATUTES OF THE UNITED STATES.
