CHAPTER 87.

[H. F. No. 570.]

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION NINETEEN (19) OF CHAPTER SIXTEEN (16), OF THE GENERAL STATUTES OF MINNESOTA OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-EIGHT (1878), RELATING TO INTOXICATING LIQUORS.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section nineteen (19) of chapter sixteen (16) of the general statutes of Minnesota of one thousand eight hundred and seventy-eight (1878), is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

SEC. 19. All persons heretofore, or that may hereafter be licensed to sell intoxicating liquors in this state, whether such license has been granted by the board of county commissioners of any county or by the officers of any city, village or town in this state, as the case may be, are hereby required to close their places of business (hotels excepted) at eleven (11) o'clock at night, and keep the same closed until five (5) o'clock in the morning; and it is hereby made unlawful between the hours last named, for persons so licensed as aforesaid, to sell, give away or otherwise dispose of any fermented or intoxicating liquors at their said place of business, or to permit the throwing of dice or playing cards, billiards or pools therein, by any minor at any time.
