

CHAPTER 20.

[S. F. No. 627.]

AN ACT TO AMEND THE CHARTER OF THE VILLAGE OF SPRING VALLEY, IN FILLMORE COUNTY; THE SAME BEING CHAPTER TWENTY-FIVE (25) OF THE SPECIAL LAWS OF THE YEAR ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-TWO (1872).

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section three (3) of chapter twenty-five (25) special laws of one thousand eight hundred and seventy-two (1872), be and the same is hereby amended by striking therefrom the words, "and one overseer of highways for each road district."

SEC. 2. That section six (6) of said chapter is hereby amended by striking therefrom the words, "and one overseer of highways for each road district."

SEC. 3. That section nine (9) of said chapter be and the same is hereby amended by adding thereto the following: "The village council shall annually appoint one overseer of highways for each road district so defined, and may prescribe his powers, duties and compensation."

SEC. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 21.

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION ONE (1) OF CHAPTER SIX (6) OF AN ACT ENTITLED "AN ACT TO AMEND AND CONSOLIDATE THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF STILLWATER," APPROVED MARCH SEVEN (7), A.D. ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE (1881).

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section one (1) of chapter six (6) of an act entitled "An act to amend and consolidate the charter of the city of Stillwater," approved March seven (7,) A. D. one thousand eight hundred and eighty-one (1881), and all amendments thereto, be and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

Section 1. The mayor shall have control and supervision of the police of the city and shall have power to appoint and remove all police officers and watchmen including the chief of police. *Provided,*

the appointment of all police officers, including the chief of police, shall be subject to the confirmation of the city council.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 22.

AN ACT TO AMEND CHAPTER TWENTY-SIX (26) OF THE SPECIAL LAWS OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA OF THE YEAR A. D. ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-SEVEN (1887), APPROVED FEBRUARY NINTH (9TH), ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-SEVEN (1887), ENTITLED AN ACT TO AMEND CHAPTER FORTY-FIVE (45) OF THE SPECIAL LAWS OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA OF THE YEAR A. D. ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-FIVE (1875), INCOPORATING THE BOROUGH OF HENDERSON, IN SIBLEY COUNTY.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That chapter twenty-six (26) of the special laws of the state of Minnesota of the year A. D. one thousand eight hundred and eighty-seven (1887), be and the same is hereby amended by adding thereto after the words "the state of Minnesota" in section twenty-nine (29) of said chapter twenty-six (26) the words, "and in the township of Tyrone in the county of Le Sueur and state of Minnesota and in the township of Blakley in the county of Scott and state of Minnesota."

SEC. 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
