

said township, the sum to be levied and certified to the county auditor; and it is hereby made the duty of the county auditor of said county to extend such amounts as the said board may certify to him, on the assessment roll of the taxable property of said township.

SEC. 3. Such tax so levied shall be collected in the same manner as prescribed by the laws of this state in relation to the collection of taxes, and the sum so collected shall be paid to the township treasurer of said township on the order of the county auditor of said county; and the town treasurer of said township shall pay said orders from the moneys received by him from such tax.

SEC. 4. That at any annual town meeting held in said township of Hutchinson the qualified voters of said township may express their approval or disapproval of this act by voting; and if at such election the majority of the voters present and voting on the approval or disapproval of this act vote against the issuing of said orders, the qualified voters of said township may again, at the next annual town meeting, express their approval or disapproval of this act by voting; those approving of this act shall have written or printed or partly written and partly printed upon their ballots the words, "For the issuing of the town orders—yes." Those not approving of this act shall have written or printed or partly written and partly printed upon their ballots the words, "For the issuing of the town orders—no." And if it shall appear that a majority of the voters present and voting at such elections upon this question or proposition shall be against the issuing of the orders as provided in this act, the orders herein authorized shall not be issued nor tax levied until the majority of the qualified voters present and voting at annual town meeting vote in favor of the issuing of said town orders. Otherwise this act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

SEC. 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER 277.

[H. F. No. 16.]

### AN ACT VALIDATING CERTAIN BONDS OF THE CITY OF MINNEAPOLIS.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :*

SECTION 1. That all bonds heretofore issued by the city of Minneapolis, under section twenty-nine (29), chapter ten (10), of the charter of said city, as heretofore amended and now existing, shall be and are hereby declared legal and valid without reference to the price for which the same were sold.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
