

CHAPTER 362.

AN ACT TO VALIDATE THE ATTEMPTED INCORPORATION OF THE VILLAGE OF BROWNS VALLEY, TRAVERSE COUNTY, MINNESOTA, UNDER AN ACT ENTITLED "AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE INCORPORATION OF VILLAGES AND TO DEFINE THEIR DUTIES AND POWERS AND TO REPEAL CERTAIN LAWS IN RELATION THERETO, APPROVED MARCH FIFTH (5TH) ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-THREE (1883), BEING CHAPTER SEVENTY-THREE (73) OF THE GENERAL LAWS OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-THREE (1883)."

WHEREAS, The village of Browns Valley, Traverse county, Minnesota, attempted to incorporate under and by virtue of chapter seventy-three (73) of the general laws of one thousand eight hundred and eighty-three (1883), being an act entitled "An act to provide for the incorporation of villages and to define their duties and powers and to repeal certain laws in relation thereto," approved March fifth (5th), one thousand eight hundred and eighty-three (1883); and,

WHEREAS, It appears that such attempted incorporation was not in all respects conducted in accordance with the letter of said act; but that notwithstanding said village has gone on and conducted its affairs as though such attempted incorporation had been fully in accordance with said act; therefore,

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the attempted incorporation of said village of Browns Valley, Traverse county, Minnesota, under chapter seventy-three (73) of the general laws of one thousand eight hundred and eighty-three (1883), being an act entitled, "An act to provide for the incorporation of villages and to define their duties and powers and to repeal certain laws in relation thereto," be and the same is hereby declared valid, and that all acts done or performed by said village under the said attempted re-incorporation shall and do have the same force and effect as though said re-incorporation had been in all respects fully in accordance with said act of one thousand eight hundred and eighty-three (1883), and that said village is now incorporated fully under said act of one thousand eight hundred and eighty-three (1883) and all subsequent acts passed connected therewith or in any manner relating thereto, and any general laws relating to the incorporation, duties and powers of villages, and shall have all the powers and duties of villages incorporated under any of the general laws of the state of Minnesota.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
