AN ACT TO DETACH THE VILLAGE OF NICOLLET IN THE COUNTY OF NICOLLET AND STATE OF MINNESOTA FROM THE TOWN OF NICOLLET IN SAID COUNTY, AND MAKE SAID VILLAGE A SEPARATE ELECTION DISTRICT.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That all the territory included within the boundaries of the village of Nicollet, a village corporation duly organized and existing under the general laws of the state of Minnesota relating to the incorporation of villages, and situate in the county of Nicollet and state of Minnesota, is hereby detached and separated from the township of Nicollet in said county, so that said town of Nicollet shall not hereafter have or exercise any jurisdiction, authority or control what-

soever within the limits of said village.

SEC. 2. That said village of Nicollet is hereby made a separate election district and the village council is hereby authorized to fix by ordinance the place of holding elections in said district, and shall at least thirty (30) days prior to any general election appoint three (3) qualified electors of said district who shall be judges of election therein, and the judges so selected shall appoint two (2) qualified electors of said district as clerks of election. That at least thirty (30) days prior to any town meeting or general election in said town of Nicollet the board of supervisors shall select the place where such meeting shall be held and cause due notice thereof to be given to the qualified electors of said town, and such town meeting or election shall be held at the place so designated.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its

passage.
