## CHAPTER 385.

[S. F. No. 179.]

AN ACT TO FIX THE COMPENSATION OF THE COUNTY TREASURER OF WRIGHT COUNTY.

## Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

The compensation of the county treasurer of Wright Section 1. county, in lieu of the compensation now allowed by law, and in lieu of all fees and percentages now or hereafter allowed and paid to said treasurer, whether from the state of Minnesota or otherwise, shall be a salary of fourteen hundred (1400) dollars per annum and no more; said salary shall be payable in twelve (12) equal installments, one at the end of each month, on the auditor's warrant, out of the county treasury.

Sec. 2. An allowance of one hundred (100) dollars per annum and no more, is hereby granted for compensation of a clerk for said treasurer. The said treasurer shall at the end of every month, or at the end of any shorter period of time during which any such clerk may be employed, furnish to such clerk a certificate showing the number of days employed and the amount of compensation such clerk is entitled to for such time of service, and upon the presentation of said certificate the county auditor shall issue to such clerk his warrant for the same, which shall be paid out of the county treasury; and the allowance for clerk hire shall in all cases be for actual services rendered.

Sec. 3. It shall be the duty of said treasurer to make report in writing, on the first (1st) day of each month to the county auditor, of all fees and percentages received by him from any and all sources for the preceding month; and the said treasurer shall, at the same time. audit all such sums and amounts to the county revenue fund of said county; and said reports shall be kept on file in the auditor's office. and shall be laid before the board of county commissioners at their

last meeting in each year.

When the county commissioners shall order any county treasurer of said county to visit the several towns in said county for the purpose of collecting taxes, then and in that case, and in all such cases, the said board shall audit and allow to said treasurer his reasonable and necessary cost and expenses for the performance of such Provided, that said treasurer shall first present to said board an itemized statement of such cost and expenses, duly verified; and provided, further, that in no case shall the sum so allowed exceed two hundred (200) dollars.

All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with the provisions of this act, are hereby repealed, so far as they apply to the said county of Wright, and no general law which may be passed in the future, shall be construed to apply to said county when any of its provisions are in conflict with this act, unless such application is specifically mentioned.

Sec. 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after the first (1st) day of January, eighteen hundred and ninety (1890).

## CHAPTER 386.

[H, F. No. 585,]

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE HOLDING OF THE V TION OF THE VILLAGE OF NEW PRAGUE ON THE SECOND TUESDAY OF APRIL AND FOR THE ELECTION OF A VILLAGE ASSESSOR AT SAID ELECTION.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the annual election of village officers of the village of New Prague shall hereafter be held on the second Tuesday of April of each year instead of the second Tuesday of March.

SEC. 2. That the electors of the village of New Prague at the annual election of village officers in said village shall hereafter elect a village assessor who shall hold his office and perform all the duties of village assessor as required by the provisions of chapter one hundred and forty-five (145) of the general laws of eighteen hundred and eighty-five (1885).

SEC. 3. All acts or parts of acts so far as inconsistent with the

provisions of this act are hereby repealed.

Sec. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER 387.

AN ACT MAKING IT THE DUTY OF COUNTY ATTORNEY OF RAMSEY COUNTY TO EXAMINE AND CERTIFY TO THE EFFECT OF CERTAIN DEEDS.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. It shall be the duty of the county attorney of Ramsey county to examine any deed of real estate lying within his county
