

CHAPTER 424.

AN ACT FIXING THE COMPENSATION OF THE CLERK OF THE DISTRICT COURT OF RAMSEY COUNTY FOR THE SERVICES OF DEPUTY CLERKS IN ATTENDANCE UPON COURT.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the clerk of the district court of Ramsey county shall be and he is hereby entitled to compensation for the services of a deputy clerk for each and every judge of the district court of Ramsey county in the sum of three (3) dollars per day each, which said sum the said clerk is hereby entitled and authorized to draw out of the county treasury of Ramsey county at the end of each and every month.

SEC. 2. All laws, whether special or general, contravening the provisions of this act are hereby repealed.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 425.

AN ACT TO CREATE A POLICE PENSION FUND FOR RETIRED POLICEMEN AND THE WIDOWS AND CHILDREN OF POLICEMEN KILLED WHILE IN ACTUAL PERFORMANCE OF POLICE DUTY IN AND FOR THE CITY OF SAINT PAUL.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. The mayor and treasurer of the city of Saint Paul, and the committee on police from the common council of the said city, are hereby constituted a board of trustees of the police pension fund created by this act. The mayor of the city shall be chairman of the board, and one of the members of the board shall be chosen secretary and the city treasurer of the city of Saint Paul shall be treasurer of the board. Such board of trustees shall have charge of and administer said fund, and take all necessary and proper actions and proceedings in the premises, and make payments from said fund of pensions granted in pursuance of this act. The said board of trustees shall report to the common council of said city annually, at the first meeting of that body in January, the condition of the police pension fund, and of the amount of moneys received and paid out by said board.
