CHAPTER 458.

AN ACT TO REGULATE THE CATCHING OF FISH IN EAGLE LAKE, KANDIYOHI COUNTY.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to catch or destroy any fish with seines, dip nets, or gill nets in Eagle Lake,

Kandiyohi county, Minnesota, at any time.

SEC. 2. Any person or persons violating any of the provisions of the preceding section of this act, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall suffer and pay a fine of not less than ten (10) dollars nor more than fifty (50) dollars and costs of prosecution, and in default of the payment of such fine and costs, shall be committed to the county jail for a term of not less than ten (10) days nor more than thirty (30) days for each and every offense.

SEC. 3. All prosecutions under the provisions of this act shall be commenced by complaint, under oath, within sixty (60) days from the time the offense was committed, and all fines collected under the provisions of this act shall be paid into the county common school fund

of said Kandivohi county.

SEC. 4. Suits may be commenced and prosecuted by any person having knowledge of violation of this act, before any justice of the peace in said Kandiyohi county.

SEC. 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after

its passage.

CHAPTER 459.

[S. F. No. 398.]

AN ACT ENTITLED AN ACT TO PREVENT THE DESTRUCTION OF FISH IN THE WATERS OF OTTER TAIL COUNTY.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota.

Section 1. No person shall at any time take, catch or kill any fish of any kind, except sturgeon, from or in any of the waters of the county of Otter Tail, in this state, in any other manner than by angling for them with a hook and line; provided, that it shall be lawful for any person to take all kinds of fish in said waters by fishing for the same with nets before the first (1st) day of March and after the thirtieth (30th) day of September, in any year; and provided, that it
