

conviction of any person violating any of the provisions of this act, the other half ($\frac{1}{2}$) thereof to be paid into the school fund of the school district within which said offense was committed.

SEC. 4. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with this act are hereby repealed.

SEC. 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 479.

[H. F. No. 1015.]

AN ACT TO PRESCRIBE THE TIME WITHIN WHICH SPECKLED TROUT MAY BE TAKEN IN GOODHUE, WABASHA AND OLMSTED COUNTIES AND TO REPEAL ALL LAWS INCONSISTENT THEREWITH.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. It shall be lawful for any person to take with rod and line, within the counties of Goodhue, Wabasha and Olmsted in this state, speckled trout and to have the same so taken in his possession at any time between the first (1st) day of April and the fifteenth (15th) day of September in each year.

SEC. 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with this act are hereby repealed.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 480.

[S. F. No. 56.]

AN ACT TO REGULATE THE CATCHING OF FISH IN DEAN LAKE IN THE TOWNSHIP OF ROCKFORD, AND IN LAKE CONSTANCE IN THE TOWNSHIP OF BUFFALO, IN WRIGHT COUNTY.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That it shall be unlawful for any person or persons to catch, kill or destroy any fish, in any manner whatever in Dean Lake in the township of Rockford, or in Lake Constance in the township of Buffalo, in Wright county, between the first (1st) day of December
