AN ACT TO CHANGE THE BOUNDARIES OF SCHOOL DISTRICTS NUMBERS SEVENTEEN (17) AND TWENTY-TWO (22), YELLOW MEDICINE COUNTY, MINNESOTA.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the northeast quarter of section twenty-two (22), the north half $\binom{1}{2}$ of section twenty-three (23) and the north half $\binom{1}{2}$ of section twenty-four (24) of township one hundred and sixteen (116), range forty (40), be and the same is hereby detached from school district number twenty-two (22) and attached to district number seventeen (17), in the county of Yellow Medicine.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after

its passage.

CHAPTER 489.

[S. F. No. 437.]

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE ORGANIZATION OF A NEW SCHOOL DISTRICT OUT OF A PORTION OF SCHOOL DISTRICT NUMBER SIX (6) IN THE COUNTY OF DAKOTA, MINNESOTA.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota.

SECTION 1. That the legal voters of that portion of school district number six (6) in the county of Dakota, within the following boundaries, viz:

Sections numbers thirty-two (32), thirty-three (33), thirty-four (34), and the south half of the southwest quarter $(s_2^1 s w_4^1)$ and south half of southeast quarter $(s_2^1 s e_4^1)$ of section twenty-seven (27), and south half of southwest quarter $(s_2^1 s w_4^1)$, and south half of southeast quarter $(s_2^1 s e_4^1)$ of section twenty-eight (28), all in town twenty-eight (28), range twenty-three (23), are hereby authorized to organize a school district to be numbered by the county auditor of said county.

The said district to comprise and embrace the territory above designated and the same to be organized in the manner prescribed by the General Laws of the State.

SEC. 2 This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
