AN ACT TO DETACH CERTAIN TERRITORY FROM INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT NUMBER ONE (1) IN LE SUEUR COUNTY AND TO ATTACH SUCH TERRITORY TO COMMON SCHOOL DISTRICT NUMBER FIFTY-SIX (56) IN SAID COUNTY.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the following described lands to-wit: The east half of the northeast quarter (e_2^1 of ne_4^1) and the southeast quarter (se_4^1) of section numbered thirty-one (31) in township number one hundred and twelve (112) north, of range number twenty-five (25) west, of the fifth (5th) principal meridian in the state of Minnesota and county of Le Sueur, be and the same is hereby detached from independent school district number one (1) in said county and attached and made a part of common school district number fifty-six (56) in said county.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after February one (1), one thousand eight hundred and eighty-nine (1889).

AN ACT TO AMEND SEOTION SIX (6) OF AN ACT ENTITLED "AN ACT CREATING AN INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT IN THE TOWN OF TAYLORS FALLS AND S FATE OF MINNESOTA," APPROVED MAROH SIXTH (6TH), A. D. EIGHTEEN HURDRED AND SEVENTY-ONE (1871).

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION. 1. That section six (6) of chapter one hundred and three (103) of the special laws of the state of Minnesota approved March sixth, (6th), A. D. one thousand eight hundred and seventy-one (1871), be and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

"It shall be the duty of said board of education, as soon as sufficient funds shall be realized therefor, to establish and maintain within the limits of said district, such number and grades of schools as said board shall deem for the best interests of said district. *Provided*, the number of grades shall not exceed four, to-wit:

"Primary department, intermediate department, grammar department and high school department, and to classify the pupils attending said schools in corresponding classes, with reference to the branches of study pursued and their proficiency therein, so that there shall be
